On the day that David Kelly killed himself you should have resigned. That death symbolised the whole sorry mess of deceit, exaggeration and incompetence that is the Iraq disaster

I remember you telling a cocky student on television that if 500,000 civilians were likely to die (his contention) you wouldn't countenance invasion. So, it's a matter of numbers? Five hundred thousand too much for you but ten or twenty thousand that will do. And the wounded? Tens of thousands of them, without limbs, or sight or hearing. These are the people making the sacrifice for your vision, not you or us. Did you ever consider whether they actually wanted to make this sacrifice? Did you ask them? Did you even ask us? Did you lay out the evidence, the ifs and the buts, the risks, the things that could decide? No, you didn't and shame on you for that deception. Just as I felt contaminated when George Bush came here in February so I feel enraged and impotent that you are still our prime minister. Please go, and go now
